RE: CONTRACT #7906
ASPHALTIC CONCRETE SUPPLY FOR PLANT

The following is a report from the Purchasing Agent regarding tenders for Contract #7906.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the recommendation of the Purchasing Agent be adopted.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the lowest tender submitted by Winvan Paving Limited in the amount of \$82,929.60 be accepted with final payment to be based on unit prices tendered and actual quantities used.

REPORT

Tenders were received up to 1500 hrs. local time on Tuesday, 1979 April 17 for the subject material.

The work of this contract will include the supply of specification asphaltic concrete of approximately 4950 tonnes to be picked up by Municipal forces at the supplier's plant as required, and 800 tonnes delivered to the Corporation of Burnaby Works yard.

This contract terminates on 1980 April 30.

The contract includes a cost escalation clause of energy related materials. The Corporation will make an equitable adjustment to Contract unit prices where the asphalt work is affected by the following defined energy related material changes in price.

During the Contract term, the Contractor shall advise the Engineer in writing of any changes in the manufacturer's posted published prices, including Federal Excise Tax. The unit prices of asphaltic concrete mix shall be adjusted for payment purposes using the following proportions as a basis of calculation.

Liquid Asphalt	- 6% liquid asphalt by weight
Heating Oil	- 15 litres per tonne of asphaltic mix
Natural Gas	- 582 MJ (Megajoules) per tonne of asphaltic concrete mix supplied
Propane, Butane	- 30 litres per tonne of asphaltic concrete mix supplied.

The Supplier shall list with his tender the posted prices, rates or tariffs of each of the above materials together with a list showing his plants to be used and the materials used at each plant.

Changes in costs of other energy sources such as electricity, gasoline, lube oil, diesel fuel for trucks shall be allowed for in the Contractor's unit prices and shall not be paid for by the Corporation.

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Six tenders were received and opened in the presence of Messrs. Constable, Nuttall and representatives of the firms bidding.

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A tabulation of the tenders received is attached.

As you are aware, asphaltic supply contracts are not simply selection of the apparent low tender. It is necessary to consider truck hauling distances and resultant costs in order to determine which supplier would best serve the Corporation's interest. For this reason bidders are required to state locations of asphalt plants for use under this contract.

Plant locations noted on the tenders were as follows:

Staff from the Engineering Department have taken into consideration travelling distances to the various plants.
