- (d) THAT authority be granted to the Returning Officer to appoint his own Deputy Returning Officers.

R E P O R T

Section 52 of the "Municipal Act" provides:

"52. (1) The Council shall, for the annual elections in each year and at other times as required, appoint

- (a) A Returning Officer;
- (b) The place at which nominations will be held;
- (c) The place or places at which polls will be opened in case a poll is required; and

(d) Such Deputy Returning Officers as are required who will preside at the respective polling-places, or delegate to the Returning Officer the power to appoint such Deputy Returning Officers,

and otherwise arrange for the holding of the annual or other election.

(2) No person shall be appointed by the Council or by the Returning Officer for the purposes of an election who has been or is employed by any other person in or about the election."

Section 53 of the "Municipal Act" provides in part:

"53. ... and the nomination shall be held in each year, at the place appointed on the last Monday of October (October 29) from ten o'clock in the forenoon to twelve o'clock Noon, and, ... the polling (if any) shall be held on the Third Saturday of November (November 17) from eight o'clock in the forenoon to eight o'clock in the afternoon."

Sections 27 and 30 of the "Public Schools Act" provide in part:

"27. (1) The duty of conducting elections of trustees is,
 (a) subject to clause (d), in a municipality within a school district, the duty of the Municipal Council;
 (b) in the rural area in any school district, the duty of the Board;
 (c) in a rural school district, the duty of the Board;
 (d) in a school district comprising one or more than one municipality and a rural area where the trustees are elected at large, the duty of the Board."

"30. The annual nomination and election of such number of trustees from a municipality or a portion of a municipality as is necessary under the provisions of this Act to maintain the requisite number of trustees for the municipality or the portion of the municipality on the Board of the school district in which the municipality or the portion of the municipality is included shall be held at the same time and conducted in the same manner as the annual election of members of the Council in the municipality and by the Returning Officer appointed for such annual election."
