## REPORT

The Planning Department is in receipt of an application to subdivide 9860 Rathburn Drive and 9775 Broadway, as more particularly outlined on the attached

Proposed Lot 166 is owned and will be retained by the Corporation for park purposes. However, it will be necessary to effect the exchange shown on the sketch in order that subdivision can proceed. It is noted that the portion of Corporation property to be exchanged falls within the future fill area for Broadway, and no development would be permitted in this section.

The proposed transaction will involve approximately 209.9 m<sup>2</sup> (2,257 sq.ft.) of privately-owned property in exchange for approximately 207.76 m<sup>2</sup> (2,234 sq. ft.) of Corporation property. The Municipal Solicitor has confirmed that he would approve the land exchange as proposed without any cash adjustments to any party.

In order to advance this subdivision application, it is therefore necessary that Council approve the land exchange proposal as recommended by the Director of Planning.




