COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

A twenty-eight-year-old Burnaby man faces charges of Attempted Murder arising out of a neighbourhood altercation in which the victim was stabbed in the chest while intervening in the assault of his wife by the accused.

A total of eight Armed Robberies were investigated during the month. Five of the establishments were neighbourhood grocery and convenience stores. Other victimized premises included a self-serve gas station, a restaurant, and an arts and crafts gift shop. Three persons, including one female, have been charged to date.
