 Shape, fill, and grade Area preparatory to
 landscaping, as provided for and approved
 in 1979 C.I.P. Budget.
 CHARGE: Code 70 \$ 65,880

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Corporation
 has a long-standing commitment to landscape
 the former Stride Avenue Refuse Disposal
 Area in keeping with its green belt
 designation. The majority of the basic
 filling has been done but some shaping,
 filling, and grading remains to be carried
 out before landscaping work can proceed.

22-252 Laurel Street, Ardingley - Kensington.
 Construct 1,000 feet of 8" ø water
 main including renewals on Ardingley
 and Sprott Street where required.
 CHARGE: Code 20-02 \$ 70,000

 required in conjunction with the Local
 Improvement Project on Norland Avenue.
