

Appearing on the agenda for 1979 October 17 is a letter from the Burnaby Tennis Club requesting permission to put forward a proposal to place an air-support structure over six proposed new tennis courts at the Burnaby Lake Sports Complex. Funds for the construction of these tennis courts are included in the year 1980 of the Commission's five-year plan and will now come forward for consideration in conjunction with the establishment of the 1980 Capital Program. The tennis club's proposal is based on the assumption that these courts will have sufficient priority to remain in the construction program in the year 1980. The Commission has not yet made this decision and consideration of this part of the Capital Budget will not be concluded until the 1980 Capital Budget has been finally adopted by Council in approximately mid-May, 1980.

Staff would therefore suggest that the tennis club's proposal is premature and that the club be advised that further consideration will be given to their request once the Capital Budget has been adopted in May of 1980. Mr. Victor T. Lipp, Chairman of the Tennis Club's Bubble Committee has been advised of this position.

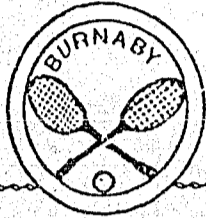

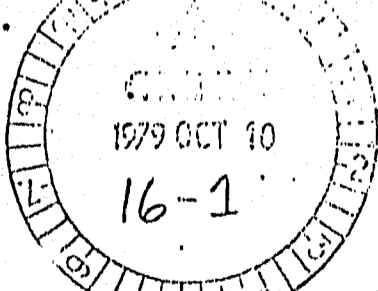
Our plans will be based on financing this project ourselves, however, assistance will be sought from all possible sources.
