COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Three persons were killed in separate motor vehicle accidents during June, bringing to five the number of fatalities this year.

- A New Westminster resident was killed instantly when his vehicle was struck by a second vehicle which crossed the centre line. Charges have been laid against the driver of the second vehicle.

- An 83-year-old Burnaby resident was killed when she attempted to cross a major traffic artery under heavy traffic conditions. No charges are contemplated against the driver of the vehicle.

- In a single vehicle incident, a 62-year-old Chilliwack resident died when the vehicle in which she was a passenger struck a lamp standard.

Investigation is continuing into the rape of a Burnaby resident by an unknown male who entered her apartment via an unlocked balcony door. This is the second incident of this nature reported, the mode of offence identical in both instances
