- In a single vehicle incident, a 62-year-old Chilliwack resident died when the vehicle in which she was a passenger struck a lamp standard.

Investigation is continuing into the rape of a Bunnaby resident by an unknown male who entered her apartment via an unlocked balcony door. This is the second incident of this nature reported, the mode of offence identical in both instances
