REPORT


On 1979 April 30 Council requested that the Planning Department report on alternative means of dealing with identified access/egress problems from the Canada Way/Rayside area neighbourhood north of Canada Way. This matter had been previously brought before Council and the Traffic Safety Committee by residents of the area.

The Planning Department has been giving priority to this study, and has explored the various options that present themselves in order to provide Council with the report requested. As the cost implications of the various alternatives will be important factors in Council's consideration of alternatives for this area, we are at this time obtaining refined estimates of costs for land acquisitions and for construction work that are entailed in the various alternatives.

It is expected that the further detailed information that is required will be available within the next week to ten days, and as a result we expect to be able to provide Council with the report it has requested at the 1979 August 13 meeting of Council.
