A 16-year-old Burnaby youth was killed in a motorcycle/vehicle accident. The youth had been travelling at a high rate of speed with no helmet when a vehicle changed lanes in front of him, causing the collision.

Investigation is continuing into two separate incidents of the reported rape of two Burnaby females by an unknown male who entered their apartments via unlocked windows. Two previous incidents reported in the past two months had identical modes of entry.
