
RECOMMENDATION:

The Fire Services Act was legislated by an Amendment to the Fire Marshal Act, Order-In-Council 129 refers, ATTACHMENT "A".

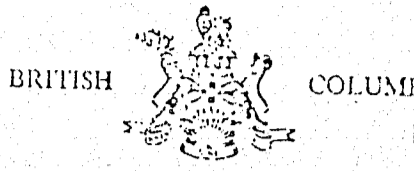

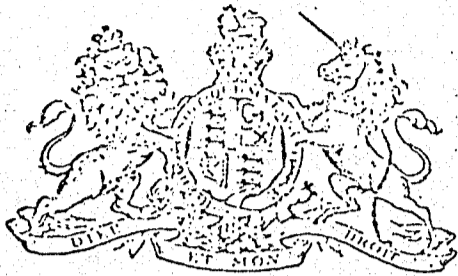
