REPORT

The Ministry of Provincial Secretary and Government Services - Recreation and Fitness Branch provides a "Special Projects - New Programs" grant.

This grant was applied for by the Big Brothers of Burnaby to operate a Boys' Summer Camp. The total project cost was estimated at \$1,300.00.

It is a stipulation of the Ministry that all "New Programs" grants must be processed and submitted by the local Parks and Recreation Department or Commission. The intent is to ensure that the local recreation department is fully aware of all recreation-related projects. It also helps to ensure that the project is a viable service for the community.

As the representing agency the grant of \$1,300 will be made payable to the Corporation of Burnaby upon submission of the project expense claim. These forms are being completed by Big Brothers and will be processed by the Parks and Recreation Department. The grant will be forwarded to Big Brothers of Burnaby upon its receipt.
