
REPORT

With reference to the subject delegation to Council on 1979 March 26 regarding litter, traffic and vehicular parking problems in the Barnet Road area, we would submit the following information pertaining to the street litter and vehicular repairs portion of the complaint.

On 1979 April 04 an inspection of the 7100 Block Barnet Road, 7000 Block Inlet Drive, 7000/7200 Block Hastings Street and 7000/7200 Block Pandora Street revealed a definite need for street and curb litter cleaning which was subsequently carried out by the Engineering Department. At the time of inspection, there were no vehicles being repaired on the street.

During inspection of the subject area, two vacant lots in the 7100 Block Barnet Road were noted to be in contravention of the Burnaby Unsightly Premises By-law No. 5533. The owners of the properties were contacted and requested to clear the lots of refuse and debris. A 1979 April 24 re-inspection of the lots revealed that the requested work had been carried out.
