RE: LETTER FROM MR. BOB LEWARNE,
7110 GILLEY AVENUE, BURNABY, V5J 4X2
POLITICAL SIGNS

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve Mr. Bob Lewarne's request for permission to erect political signs subject to his assurance in writing that such erection will be in compliance with Clause (9), Schedule No. 1 of the Burnaby Sign By-Law; and
2. THAT Council approve the erection of political signs on municipality property by all participants in the forthcoming federal and provincial elections subject to affected parties or associations signifying in writing that such erection will be undertaken in compliance with Clause (9), Schedule No. 1 of the Burnaby Sign By-Law; and
3. THAT a copy of this report be sent to all participating political associations and independent candidates in the municipality.

REPORT

Appearing on the agenda for the 1979 April 09 meeting of Council is a request from Mr. Bob Lewarne for permission to erect political signs in connection with a forthcoming election.

Burnaby Sign By-law 6163 includes provision for election signs under Clause (9) of Schedule No. 1 which reads as follows:

"Temporary signs pertaining to campaigns, drives or events of political, civic, philanthropic, educational or religious organizations, provided that the permission of the Council must be obtained to erect such signs upon or over public property and provided further that such signs shall be removed within 3 days after the event".

Although it is not a requirement of the By-law, it is advisable to nevertheless have from persons wishing to engage in such activity an assurance in writing they will comply with Clause (9) of Schedule No. 1.
