Recommendation

1. THAT Council approve, in principle, the Burnaby Trail Study as the basis for compiling a detailed yearly "Trail Development Program" which will provide for the implementation of the Trail System on a staged basis.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1979 December 05 the Parks and Recreation Commission received the attached report on the subject study. The study was discussed in detail at the Commission meeting of 1979 December 19 at which time the Commission approved the following recommendations:

1. That the Commission approve the Burnaby Trail Study as the basis for compiling a detailed yearly "Trail Development Program" which will provide for the implementation of the Trail System on a staged basis.
2. That subject to approval of the Trail System Plan in principle, by Council, Parks and Recreation staff be authorized to prioritize the plan over a long-term basis including costs of development and upkeep.
3. That the Commission so recommend to Council.

The Planning Department has completed its final draft of the subject study which is intended to provide a comprehensive guide plan for the establishment of a Municipal trail system.
