RECOMMENDATION:

REPORT

Council has received a letter from the Secretary of CUPE, Local 23, on hehalf of the Inside/Outside/Foremen's Divisions requesting that bargaining commence for the 1981 agreements.

A similar letter has been forwarded by Local 23 to the Burnaby Public Library Board with respect to the Library employees agreement.

Section 6.2(1) of the Labour Code of B.C. provides as follows:

"Either party to a collective agreement, whether entered into before or after the coming into force of this Act may, at any time within four months immediately preceding the date of expiry of the agreement, by written notice, require the other party to the agreement to commence collective bargaining."

The appropriate steps are being taken to commence collective bargaining for the 1981 agreements and further reports and recommendations will be made as matters progress.
