SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR STREET BAR-B-QUE - NORTHCLIFFE CRESCENT

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- THAT Council approve of the closure of Northcliffe Crescent on Saturday, 1980 June 21, for the purpose of a neighbourhood Bar-B-Que subject to the conditions contained within the report of the Municipal Engineer.
- 2. THAT Mrs. Patricia Williamson of 452 Northcliffe Crescent be notified of Council's approval and the conditions of the Municipal Engineer.

REPORT

The captioned request was received in the form of a petition signed by all the current residents of Northcliffe Crescent. In view of the complete neighbourhood support of the requested Bar-B-Que and the lack of any apparent detrimental effects we are recommending that Council approve the request subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the barricades, supplied by the Municipality, be installed on Northcliffe at least 10 metres from the intersection with Cliff Avenue to permit a turn around area for Cliff Avenue.
- 2. That the closure to be in effect only between 16:00 to 22:00 hours on Saturday, 80 06 21.

The Health Department have advised that a permit is required for the handling of food and that the applicant is in possession of a valid permit.

The R.C.M.P. were consulted on this report and concur with the contents herein.
