1. THAT Council approve of the closure of Northcliffe Crescent on Saturday, 1980 June 21, for the purpose of a neighbourhood Bar-B-Que subject to the conditions contained within the report of the Municipal Engineer.
2. THAT Mrs. Patricia Williamson of 452 Northcliffe Crescent be notified of Council's approval and the conditions of the Municipal Engineer.

REPORT


The captioned request was received in the form of a petition signed by all the current residents of Northcliffe Crescent. In view of the complete neighbourhood support of the requested Bar-B-Que and the lack of any apparent detrimental effects we are recommending that Council approve the request subject to the following conditions:

1. That the barricades, supplied by the Municipality, be installed on Northcliffe at least 10 metres from the intersection with Cliff Avenue to permit a turn around area for Cliff Avenue.
2. That the closure to be in effect only between 16:00 to 22:00 hours on Saturday, 80 06 21.

The Health Department have advised that a permit is required for the handling of food and that the applicant is in possession of a valid permit.

The R.C.M.P. were consulted on this report and concur with the contents herein.
