COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Investigation is continuing into a number of armed robbery offences which occurred during the month:

- A jewellery store was robbed of \$1,699 worth of rings;
- A convenience store was robbed of \$150 cash;
- A bank was robbed of approximately \$5,000 cash;

In all instances, the perpetrator was a lone male armed with a handgun, although the three appear unrelated.

Charges of armed robbery, forcible confinement and assault have been laid against a male and a female after an incident in which the caretaker of a medical building was bound and beaten by two assailants armed with knives. Acquisition of drugs appears to be the motive of the offence.

The apprehension of a juvenile male during February resulted in the solving of thirteen break and enter offences in Burnaby dating back to August of 1979.
