COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS

A routine vehicle check resulted in the recovery of a stolen vehicle and the solving of thirteen Break & Enter offences which occurred throughout the Municipality during a previous two-month period. A juvenile stands charged.

Investigation is continuing into the Armed Robbery of a Burnaby motel, which netted the perpetrators \$200.00. During the commission of the offence, the night clerk was seized and forced at knifepoint to open a safe containing the night deposits.

A Vernon resident has been charged with Attempted Rape as a result of an incident in which a female jogger was accosted near a park site. Intervention by an area resident who observed the incident caused the accused to flee contributed to his subsequent apprehension.

A twenty-year-old Ruskin man was killed in a single vehicle accident in January. The subject died as a result of injuries sustained when he was thrown from his vehicle after it left the roadway. roadway.
