The Girl Guides received grants for the year 1977 of \$500., for 1978 \$500., for 1979 \$750.

The request for 1980 of \$2,000. is to fund operation of a part-time office and secretary.

Council should be aware the Girl Guides have withdrawn from the United Way as of January 1, 1980 and consequently do not receive funding from that source.

Considering that the Girl Guides could have received funding from the United Way but have chosen to withdraw, and considering that they do have the people resources to fund-raise as part of their activities, your Committee would recommend that no grant be given.

The Society was founded in 1931. It is a private social work agency with volunteer directors.

The Society provides information, assistance, and counselling to families of persons who have come into conflict with the law.

The objectives of the Society are to assist the families and dependents of these people who may be confined in penal institutions to assist in the rehabilitation and re-establishment of persons discharged from such institutions.

The request is for \$1,800., the same amount as that granted for 1977, 1978 and 1979.

The Committee feels that the Society is adequately funded from other sources, i.e. Federal Government, Provincial Government, United Way, and should rightfully be funded by those sources. (See attached financial statement).

Your Committee would therefore recommend that no grant be given.
