COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

An eighteen-year-old Burnaby resident has been charged with a wounding offence as a result of an incident where a high school student was shot in the face with a pellet gun. The victim was treated in hospital and released.

An employee of a local fast food outlet was robbed at gunpoint of in excess of \$4,000 while enroute to deposit the day's receipts.

In unrelated incidents, a self-serve gas station and a local convenience store were robbed of small amounts of cash. In each case, the perpetrator was a lone male armed with a handgun.

Information received from a Burnaby banking establishment led to the arrest of a local youth and the solving of eight break & enter incidents. Bank employees became suspicious when the youth brought in large amounts of coin over a two-day period.

The arrest of three youths at the scene of a break & enter resulted in the solving of eleven additional offences committed between January and March, 1980 by this group.
