
Background:

The C.A.F.C. as the official voice of Canadian Fire Chiefs is devoting this year's meeting to the theme "Emergency Preparedness", the subject matter will be reviewing at first hand, the Mississauga Freight Derailment; Bill C-25, an Act to Promote Public Safety in the Transport of Dangerous Goods.

In addition to these current areas of concern, the Director-Fire Services, as Chairman of the C.A.F.C. Fire Prevention Committee, will be presenting his Annual Committee Report to the membership, a report which will recommend the Executive Committee's activities be directed to specific matters affecting the safety of the general public.

Cost:

Total cost is \$673.00, which will include transportation, accommodation, per diem allowance and registration fee. This expenditure was provided for in the 1980 Accountability Budget.
