RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT an average increase of 7.5% rounded to the licence fees as set out in:

- 1. Burnaby Trades Licence By-law, #3089 (attached)
- 2. Burnaby Cab & Commercial Vehicle By-law, #3102 (attached)
- 3. Burnaby Cabaret Regulation By-law, #1481 (attached)
- 4. Burnaby Club Regulation By-law, #3065 (attached)
- 5. Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine By-law, #1914 (attached)

be adopted for application in 1981.

SUMMARY

This report recommends an average 7.5% increase in licence fees for 1981.

REPORT

Effective 1978 January 01, schedules of business licence fees, based on calculations to recover administration and inspectional costs only, were implemented. For the 1979 licence year the fees were adjusted to reflect the cost of inspection theory on which the system was designed; and increased by 6% rounded. For the 1980 licence year, in accordance with Council's direction, the licence classifications and fees were adjusted to correct apparent inequities in some of them and to minimize the number of classifications and separate fees. This resulted in:

- (a) one general resident business classification
- (b) fifty special resident business classifications
- (c) one non-resident business classification

A general increase of 7% rounded was implemented.

In my opinion, the adjustments that have been introduced to our classification of licences and fees has achieved the objective of recovery of costs only. The fine tuning that was implemented for 1980 provided a system that is equitable and convenient for the licencee; and is administratively cost effective for the Corporation.

To maintain our position of recovering costs, the greatest portion of which is labour, a general increase of 7.5% rounded up to the nearest \$5.00 is recommended to all classifications of licence fees to offset anticipated rising costs in 1981.

The attachments set out the current fees and the recommended 1981 fees. Based on a 7.5% increase, the minimum increase is \$5.00, and the maximum is \$50.00 on renewal licence fees, except automatic vending machines for which the minimum increase is \$1.00 per machine. Application of these rates, based on the 1981 provisional budget would increase licence revenue by an estimated \$56,000 in 1981.

The Deputy Municipal Treasurer concurs with this report.
