COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

A Burnaby man stands charged with attempted murder as a result of a stabbing incident at a local nightclub. The incident was precipitated by a jealous response by the accused to another man.

Two Quebec residents were arrested in a Vancouver hotel in connection with the March armed robbery of a Burnaby banking establishment. Both have been charged with the offence which netted over \$13,000. and, additionally, they face similar charges in Quebec. In another armed robbery, a lone suspect armed with a handgun robbed a local self-service gas station of \$100.00. This incident is believed to be related to four other gas station holdups that have occurred throughout Burnaby since November, 1979 in which a similar approach was used.
