

RE: 1980 SUMMER COUNCIL MEETINGS

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

If Council adopts the practice that has been followed in years past, meetings would be held on alternate weeks only during the months of July and August, 1980. To assist Council with its deliberations on this matter, following are the dates on which meetings would be held on this basis:

1. Meetings would be held on:

<u>Monday</u>	<u>Monday</u>	<u>Tuesday</u>
July 07	July 21	August 05

<u>Monday</u>	<u>Tuesday</u>
August 18	September 02

2. Meetings would be cancelled on:

<u>Monday</u>	<u>Monday</u>
July 14	July 28

<u>Monday</u>	<u>Monday</u>
August 11	August 25

NOTE:

- a) Monday, August 04 is a Legal Holiday (B.C. Day).
- b) The first meeting in September would be Tuesday, September 02, as Monday, September 01, is a Legal Holiday (Labour Day).

It should perhaps also be noted that at least six members of Council are planning to attend the Federation of Canadian Municipalities Annual Conference in Halifax from June 08 - 11, and that consideration should therefore be given to cancelling the regularly scheduled meeting on June 09.

It would be helpful for administrative purposes if Council would provide direction at this time on whether meetings are to be held alternatively or regularly during July and August of this year, and if the regularly scheduled meeting on June 09 is to be cancelled.
