COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Investigation is continuing into the armed robbery of a B.C. Liquor outlet. The offence was expedited by the abduction, at gunpoint, of the store's Assistant Manager. Proceeds of the offence were approximately \$11,000.00.

A Burnaby man has been arrested and charged with several offences arising out of an attempted rape incident. The method of approach in this offence is similar to others previously reported wherein the culprit would enter an apartment via an open balcony door during hours of darkness.

Identification of fingerprints would at the scene of a break and entering has resulted in the solving of thirteen similar offences which occurred between March and December of this year. A Port Moody man has been charged.

The 11th motor vehicle fatality of 1979 involved a twenty-eight-year-old Burnaby woman being struck and killed as she attempted to cross a major thoroughfare while poor visibility conditions prevailed.

A Prince George resident has been charged with criminal negligence after the investigation into the 12th motor vehicle fatality.
