REPORT

On 1980 February 25, Council adopted the following recommendations:

1. THAT Provincial Youth Employment applications Nos. 1 - 20 totalling \$156,601.60 be approved; and
2. THAT the Mayor and Municipal Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary agreements; and
3. THAT the Municipal Treasurer be designated as the signing authority in the agreements; and
4. THAT the Municipal Treasurer be directed to submit applications as approved by Council to the Ministry of Labour of the Province of British Columbia.

Seven projects to provide employment for 65 youth for 4,055 days, were not approved.

Burnaby's application was for the employment of 104 persons and a grant of \$157,497.60, inclusive of a project to employ one person at Heritage Village after Council had approved Item 18, Report No. 15, 1980 February 25. The first 13 projects in order of priority, inclusive of the Heritage Village project, have been approved to permit employment of 39 persons and a grant of \$51,820.80. The cost to Burnaby is estimated to be \$46,296.12. The seven projects not approved were designed to employ 26 outdoor leaders, 31 life-guard/aquatic instructors, 6 recreation attendants and 2 outdoor specialists.

In 1979 Burnaby applied for the employment of only 53 persons and a grant of \$76,364.80. Employment of 44 persons was approved and a grant of \$63,020.80. The actual grant received was \$58,110.40 and the cost to Burnaby was \$43,177.65 - due to a late start being made on some of the programs.

We have been advised that the drop in Burnaby's allocation of funds is due entirely to the large number of applications received commensurate with available funds. We have not been able to determine the amount of money the Province has allocated to the entire program but the dollars available collectively to member municipalities of each Regional District will be communicated to Council by the Ministry of Labour in due course.
