REPORT OF THE GRANTS AND PUBLICITY COMMITTEE

Madam/Gentlemen:

Your Committee would report as follows:

<u>Application No.</u>		<u>Recommendation</u>
44.	<u>Burnaby Horsemen's Association (Grant In Lieu Of Taxes)</u> Council on 1980 May 20 approved an amount of \$8,000.00 or an amount equal to taxes and other charges for the years 1978, 1979 and 1980, to be transferred from the Grants and Publicity Committee budget account and credited to the tax account of the Burnaby Horsemen's Association. The amount approved was only barely sufficient to cover the taxes for the years 1978 and 1979 (after penalties and accrued interest had been added) amounting to \$8,880.27. The gross taxes for 1980 are still outstanding in the amount of <u>\$4,007.68</u> . Your Committee would therefore recommend that an amount equal to the 1980 taxes plus penalties be placed in the 1981 Grants and Publicity Committee budget. (For the information of Council, interest at 12% p.a. would accrue if the \$4,007.68. was not paid by January 1, 1981).	\$4,007.68 for 1980 taxes (plus penalties).
49.	<u>Vancouver Opera</u> It is recognized that the Vancouver Opera plays an important cultural roll in the Greater Vancouver area. In 1979, the Vancouver Opera Association had a very successful year - well attended and well received performances, and a fund-raising campaign which realized \$150,000. and allowed the Association to pay off \$100,000. of its past indebtedness.
