REPORT OF THE ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION

1. Bylaw No. 7600 - "Burnaby Advisory Planning Commission Bylaw 1980"  
-A bylaw to establish an Advisory Planning Commission for the  
Municipality of Burnaby.

Recommendation:

"That the Advisory Planning Commission concur with Bylaw No. 7600  
subject to the following amendments being incorporated therein,  
namely:

1. That Section 5(3) not be deleted from the bylaw and be  
amended to read as follows:

5(3) The Planning Director or his designate of the  
Municipality shall attend all meetings of the  
Commission except when otherwise directed by the  
Commission.

2. That Section 7(2) be amended to read as follows:

7(2) Any person may request in writing, addressed to  
the Secretary, permission to be heard at a meeting  
giving the reason for the requests; and the  
Chairman shall decide whether any person or  
delegation shall be heard."

R E P O R T

Council, on 1980 November 17 referred Bylaw No. 7600 - "Burnaby  
Advisory Planning Commission Bylaw 1980" to the Municipal Solicitor  
to amend this bylaw as follows:

"That Section 3(3) be amended to provide for appointments under  
this section to be for two years."

The Advisory Planning Commission concur with this amendment.

"That Section 3(5) be amended to read - 'A member on the  
expiration of their term of office is eligible for reappointment,  
but no person shall serve for more than six years in total.'"

The Advisory Planning Commission concur with this amendment.
