SUBJECT: HASTINGS STREET PARKING RESTRICTIONS

## RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the two-month moratorium placed on the installation of "NO PARKING" signs on Hastings Street be extended until all information requested by Council can be provided, which is expected to be on 81 01 12.

## REPORT

At its meeting of 1980 September 08 Council adopted the following motion:

"THAT a moratorium be placed on the installation of "NO PARKING" signs on Hastings Street during the evening rush hours, 4 p.m. to 6 p.m., for a period of two months pending a possible solution".

In addition to the above, seven separate items of information were requested by Council. Some of these items required input from other agencies and to this end we have made enquiries and are still awaiting some responses. We also have a consultant working on a study of the Hastings Street corridor with special emphasis placed on traffic. We expect to have the consultant's report and recommendations within four weeks time.

In view of the above, it is felt that a final report with recommendations should be withheld until such time as we are able to respond to all the questions that have been raised. The information required to answer these questions should be available in time for us to submit the report to Council on 81 01 12.
