REPORT

The Canadian Association of Housing and Renewal Officials (CAHRO) is holding its Annual Conference in Winnipeg on 1980 June 15 to 19. CAHRO is a national organization funded by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) for the purpose of providing a unified and identifiable vehicle capable of policy input to the Federal Government through CMHC regarding neighbourhood improvement, housing rehabilitation and social housing. Most recently, CAHRO has been involved in the Neighbourhood Improvement and Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Programs, both of which are active in Burnaby.

The CAHRO Conference in Winnipeg will be attended by senior CMHC officials and Municipal Planners from across Canada, and presents an invaluable opportunity to exchange information and have input directly to the CMHC officials responsible for policy generation and management of neighbourhood improvement and home rehabilitation programs.

We feel that Mr. Elligott of the Planning Department, who is directly involved in neighbourhood improvement and home rehabilitation on behalf of the Municipality, would benefit considerably by attending this Conference and thus be better able to further the Municipal efforts in these areas.
