COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS :

The July report was overlooked, therefore, the stated figures represent cumulative totals for July and August.

The crime picture for July and August indicates a slight increase over the same period for 1979. Criminal Code offences increased by 7.8%; while the combined total for criminal, federal and provincial offences increased by 5.8%.

A somewhat more significant increase was experienced in traffic accident statistics with total accidents up over 22% from 1979. The numbers of persons injured or killed has also increased.

In serious crimes investigations, charges have been laid in connection with an attempt murder incident arising out of a family dispute. A second investigation is continuing into the attempted murder of a Burnaby man who sustained a gunshot wound to his thigh when an assailant entered his dwelling and began shooting.
