**COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:**

An increase in the number of sex offences has been identified over the past two months. Investigations into two rape offences have revealed sufficient similarity to suggest the same party is responsible for both; while in a third unrelated incident, a woman was attacked as she slept in her ground floor apartment. The perpetrator had gained entry via an unlocked patio door.

During the months of May and June, a rash of arson and related incidents were experienced. A fourteen-year-old male has been apprehended in connection with these incidents.

A Burnaby resident has been charged in relation to the armed robbery of a local credit union. Approximately \$2,500.00 was taken during the commission of the offence.
