 Carpenter Shop & Paint Shop - Improve ventilation and upgrade lighting.  
 Garage - Racking and lighting.  
 Stores & Service Centre - Racking and lighting.  
 Main Gate Area - Lighting and installation of electronic eye.  
 CHARGE: Code 62-003 \$16,500

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. The main purpose of upgrading the Service Centre lighting and the installation of an electronic eye is for added security.  
 One main gate is left open for call out crews and refueling of fire trucks if necessary. The electronic eye will operate at this gate.
2. Venting in the Paint Shop is a Workers' Compensation Board requirement to minimize the inhalation of toxic fumes.
3. Steel storage cabinets, racking and lighting in general stores and garage stores is partly a Workers' Compensation Board requirement and partly to increase efficiency of stores operation.

Funds are provided in 1979 Capital Budget.
