
That the following be received for information purposes.

REPORT

On 80-11-06 a copy of a letter directed to the Mayor and Council dated 80-11-04 was received from Mrs. Margaret M. Taylor, 5649 Canada Way in Burnaby, praising the R.C.M.P. for quick action on enforcing the no entry sign off Canada Way south on Sperling Avenue, and requesting enforcement of the speed limit of Canada Way to ensure safer exits from driveways.

We are unable to work a radar operation in the area of the complainant's residence because of Canada Way's configuration at that point, along with easy exit and return entrance for violators. However, over the past ten months 600 violators have been charged for speeding on Canada Way at locations of Iris, Stanley, Allman and Nursery.

Our Traffic Section will continue to monitor speeders on this busy highway.
