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- 60-14-050 Gilmore Diversion, north of Canada Way.
 Widen in order to construct separate left turn lane for south bound/east bound traffic.
 CHARGE: Capital Reserve \$ 44,700
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This work is required at this time in order to coordinate with the road standard under construction by Discovery Parks Inc. on the south side of Canada Way. The work is required for traffic management of the north/south route through Discovery Park and north of Canada Way.

 - 60-14-051 Various locations.
 Installation of loop detectors for traffic counters.
 CHARGE: Capital Reserve 5,000
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: These loops are additional to those installed under a previous allotment of \$3,000. The loop will be installed at various locations. These loops are considered a vital and integral part of traffic management and is money well spent in this function.

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60-14-049 Imperial Street, Boundary Road to Kingsway.
 Installation of signal progression.


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CHARGE: Capital Reserve
