REPORT

On 1980 November 17, Council received Item 19, Municipal Manager's Report No. 70, providing information in response to correspondence from Mr. James A. Kozak.

Appearing on the Council Agenda for 1980 December 01 is additional correspondence dated 1980 November 24 from Mr. James A. Kozak requesting further detailed information on this matter.

The Planning Department's knowledge of the Boundary Road alignment option for the link between Highway No. 1 and the Second Narrows Bridge is limited to the basic information obtained from the Ministry of Transportation and Highways to determine whether there would be any impact on the property at the north-east corner of Hastings Street and Boundary Road. The Planning Department has therefore written to the Ministry of Transportation and Highways requesting that the Ministry provide such details as are currently available on the Boundary Road alignment option. When this information has been received from the Ministry of Transportation and Highways, it will be forwarded to Council.
