
TO: MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
RE: VISIT TO KUSHIRO

In connection with the planned visit to Burnaby's Sister City Kushiro, the Mayor of Kushiro had asked for as wide a representation as possible from the Council, educational institutions, union organizations and the business community.

I have invited the C.U.P.E. Local 23 and International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 323, to each provide a representative as part of the official Burnaby delegation if they so wish. From the funds allocated by Council's earlier resolution, it will be possible to provide some travel and/or per diem expense assistance to representatives selected from each of our unions. In order to do so, it is necessary that the two representatives be appointed delegates of Council for the official Kushiro visit.

It is requested that Council resolve that a member from each of C.U.P.E. Local 23 and International Association of Fire Fighters Local 323 be appointed delegates of Council in accordance with details described in this report.
