1981 - 1982 REGIONAL NEGOTIATIONS
G.V.R.D./C.U.P.E. AND V.M.R.E.U.

The Municipal Manager submitted a report regarding regional negotiations, local issues, compressed work week, and cost of settlement for 1981 and 1982.

The Municipal Manager recommended:

1. THAT Council ratify the recommended joint terms of settlement and those local terms of settlement which apply to the District of Burnaby.
2. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute the amended Union Agreements.
3. THAT Council rescind the following motion which it adopted 1981 February 09; "THAT the Junior Exempt Staff be awarded the payroll component of the final offer presently before C.U.P.E. Local 23 to be effective 1981 January 01."
and
THAT Council adopt the following recommendation:
THAT those positions in the Junior Exempt staff group (i.e. positions at Pay Grade 33 and under) be granted all the same compensation terms for 1981 - 1982 as those for C.U.P.E. Local 23 except for provision #5 "Lump Sum Payment Upon Return to Work". (Explanation follows in this report)

The Meeting also considered:

Summation from the Labour Relations Department of the Greater Vancouver Regional District agreeing to recommend to the various memberships that their 1981 - 1982 collective agreements consist of the therein enumerated clauses; Comments on the settlement items for Local 23 employees - Inside, Outside, Foremen and Library agreements; Memorandum of Agreement on local matters for Inside, Outside and Foremen Employees.
Memorandum of Agreement on local matters for Library Employees; Back To Work Agreement.


