RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT permission be granted to the Fellburn Fellowship Society and the Burnaby North Lion's Club to hold a chicken barbeque on Friday and Saturday, 1981 August 14 and 15 at the Kensington Plaza, 6500 Block East Hastings Street; and
2. THAT a copy of this report be sent to Mr. Vincent Sacco, Chairman of the Fund Raising Chapter for Fellburn Fellowship Society, and Mr. Burton W. Wright, Burnaby North Lion's Club.

REPORT

The parking lot of the Royal Canadian Legion No. 148 at 4356 East Hastings Street has been a favorite location for clubs to hold fund-raising chicken barbeques.

In 1979 a local restaurant operator complained bitterly that the frequency of these events located on or near this lot were reducing his sales dramatically. This Department's representatives met with the principals of both sides and a reduction in the number of these events was negotiated that could be lived with by both parties.

The Royal Canadian Legion have selected the following dates for their 1981 chicken barbeques:

Friday and Saturday, 1981 May 01 and 02  
Friday and Saturday, 1981 June 20 and 21  
Friday, 1981 July 31 and Saturday, 1981 August 01

While we try to assist the local service organizations, we are also aware that restaurants in the area of these fund-raising events could be in strong opposition if the frequency of the barbeques "gets out of hand".

We have discussed this proposed barbeque with Mr. Burton W. Wright, applicant, and there will be on-site inspection by this Department to ensure compliance with the Provincial Regulations Governing the Sanitation and Operation of Food Premises.
