SUBJECT: PROPOSED 1981 LOCAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the Municipal Engineer be directed to have the program estimated.
2. THAT the Local Improvement Program Assessor be directed to prepare the Assessment Rolls.
3. THAT the Municipal Treasurer be directed to bring down a cost report in accordance with Section 662 of the Municipal Act.
4. THAT the Local Improvement Program Rates Bylaw be amended to reflect a rate of 46 cents per annum per taxable foot frontage for 15 years for a four-foot wide separated sidewalk.
5. THAT the Municipal Clerk be directed to prepare the Initiative Notices

REPORT:

The Municipal Council at its meeting of 81 10 05 directed that a portion of the south side of Clinton Street between Royal Oak Avenue and Roslyn Avenue be the subject of a Local Improvement Initiative sidewalk project.

The Local Improvement project would be to replace the existing four-foot wide sidewalk on the south side with a new four-foot wide sidewalk in the same location and at the same grade as the existing sidewalk. The limits of the project would be from the end of the recently constructed sidewalk on the west (12 feet west of the east property line of Lot B - 5258) to the end of the recently constructed sidewalk on the east (11 feet west of the east property line of Lot 9 - 5392) for a total length of 353 feet. The per annum rate for the project is 46 cents per foot and is predicated on the differential between the rate for curbs and the rate for curbwalks when the work forms an integral part of the street project.
