COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Investigation is continuing in relation to the shooting of two Surrey residents at a Burnaby residence. This incident appears to be drug related. One male was shot in the stomach and the second in the arm, with a handgun.

An unidentified male is being sought in connection with two bank robberies. The similarities in these robberies indicate the same male is responsible. The culprit obtained \$3,376.00 cash. A weapon was only simulated.

A Burnaby male has been charged with attempted murder. He is the driver of a vehicle which attempted to run down two pedestrians and deliberately collided with two vehicles doing considerable damage to the vehicles involved.
