 AND UNSIGHTLY PREMISES

Following is a report from the Municipal Engineer on a matter which Virginia and William Norris referred in their letter which appears on the agenda. A reply from the Chief Public Health Inspector is attached.

With respect to the correspondents comments concerning the growth of trees, municipalities do not have the power to enact a by-law that regulates their height except at intersections if they cause the view of motorists to be obstructed.

West Vancouver advises that it does not have a by-law that regulates the growth of trees.



SUMMARY:

In response to the subject letter of complaint, notices under authority of the Burnaby Unsightly Premises By-law 1969 and Amendment By-law 1980 have been forwarded to residential properties addressed 960 Gilmore Avenue and 1576 Gilmore Avenue.

REPORT

With reference to the subject letter of complaint received 1981 January 27, we would forward the following information pertinent to page 3 regarding unsightly residential properties on Gilmore Avenue.

On 1981 January 27, Mrs. Norris was contacted by telephone regarding her concern of unsightly property conditions on Gilmore Avenue. On 1981 January 28, the District Public Health Inspector surveyed Gilmore Avenue between Hastings Street and Douglas Road and inspected the property specifically mentioned in the subject letter of complaint. This survey and the specific inspection resulted in two properties addressed 960 Gilmore Avenue and 1576 Gilmore Avenue being issued 30-day cleanup notices under authority of the Burnaby Unsightly Premises By-law 1969 and Amendment By-law 1980.

Should these properties be found not to be in compliance after the expiry of the 30-day notice, we will proceed with enforcement under authority of the by-law.
