

REPORT

On the Council Agenda of 1981 February 02 is a letter from the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce regarding a proposal that has been made by Mr. Bert Benson for "a waterfront highway along the south shore of Burrard Inlet together with opening the area for industrial and commercial uses". The Chamber of Commerce has urged Council to pursue the feasibility of this plan through discussions with senior governments and neighbouring municipalities.

The Joint Technical Staff Committee, comprised of Municipal and Ministry of Transportation and Highways staff is currently giving active consideration to the feasibility of a waterfront roadway which would be an extension of the Barnet Highway through to Vancouver. This examination is being carried out in the context of the staff review of the Hastings/Gaglardi Connector and associated road proposals. It is expected that Burnaby Municipal staff, the City of Vancouver, the National Harbours Board and the Canadian Pacific Railway will be meeting to further discuss this proposal.

Upon completion of the study of the Hastings/Gaglardi Connector and related issues (including a waterfront route) a report will be placed before Council for its consideration.
