59. Vancouver Neurological Centre

This organization operates in the Greater Vancouver area. They assist in the rehabilitation of people suffering from cerebral palsy, epilepsy, Parkinson's Disease, etc.

The Vancouver Neurological Centre is a rehabilitation centre comprising 5 non-profit organizations:  
 B.C. Epilepsy Society - Vancouver Epilepsy Centre,  
 Children's Rehabilitation and Cerebral Palsy Association,  
 B.C. Parkinson's Disease Association and Myasthenia Gravis Foundation of B.C.

They offer various service and treatment facilities which are located close to the complex of medical and paramedical organizations in the locality of the Vancouver General Hospital.

In 1977, 1978, 1979 and 1980, they received a grant of \$3,500.00. Your Grants Committee would again recommend a grant of \$3,500.00.

60. Boy Scouts of Canada - Burnaby Region
