Recommendation:

R E P O R T

On Wednesday, 1981 May 13 the Justice Council/Family Court Committee met with Miss Wendy Rowe from the Ministry of the Attorney-General's Department to review the process and effectiveness evaluation presently being conducted of Burnaby Youth Services Division.

Arising out of the discussion regarding this matter, your Committee feels that the Youth Services Division's role of providing a Family Counselling Program for pre-delinquent and first offenders is a much needed Preventative Program for juvenile delinquency in Burnaby.

Further, because funding will become the sole responsibility of the Municipality of Burnaby in approximately three years time, your Committee is of the opinion that a direct line of communication be established between the Municipal Council and the Youth Services Division which would make the Youth Services Division directly accountable to the Municipal Council.
