RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve project priorities Nos. 1-5 as outlined in this report for application for Recreation Facilities Grants.
2. THAT, following compilation of the necessary supporting materials, the Municipal Treasurer file the application for grants with the Provincial Recreation Facilities Assistance Program, Recreation Division Branch.

REPORT:

At its meeting of 1981 July 08, the Parks and Recreation Commission approved the following program for grant submissions to the Recreation Facilities Assistance Program of the Provincial Government.

<u>Project</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
1. Expansion of C. G. Brown Pool	\$353,000.00
2. Construction of 6 lighted tennis courts - Burnaby Lake	\$130,000.00
3. Bonsor Park - provision of lighted field	\$100,000.00
4. Confederation Park - fieldhouse	\$ 55,000.00
5. Harwood Park - construction of playground	\$ 20,000.00

The Commission was also advised that two Community Groups - Buckingham School Parents group and the B.C.I.T. Students' Association were planning projects which they would like to have considered for grant submissions.

If plans are submitted by these two groups in time to meet the October 01, 1981 Provincial deadline, these projects will be included on the priority list for grant applications. Otherwise the requests could be considered for the 1982 submission.
