R E P O R T

Section 84 of the "Municipal Act" provides:

"84. (1) *The Council shall, for the annual election and an election at other times as required, appoint a Returning Officer, designate a nomination place, one or more voting places and appoint a deputy returning officer for each voting place. The Council may delegate to the returning officer power to appoint a deputy returning officer.*

(2) *No person shall be appointed by the council or by the returning officer for the purposes of an election who has been or is employed by another person in or about the election."*

Sections 85 and 86 of the "Municipal Act" provide:

"85. *After the first election, the nomination for mayor shall be held in every second year, and the nomination for aldermen shall, subject to section 86, be held in each year, at the place designated, on the last Monday of October from 10 a.m. to 12 noon, and, except for any advance poll as provided in section 88, the polling, if any, shall be held on the 3rd Saturday of November from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m."*


"86.

A municipal council may provide, by bylaw and notwithstanding any other provisions of this Act or the letters patent, that all aldermen shall be elected biennially. The bylaw shall provide for the transition from an annual election to a biennial election of aldermen."

Section 30 of the "School Act" provides:

"30.

The annual nomination and election of the number of trustees from all or part of a municipality that is necessary under this Act to maintain the requisite number of trustees for the municipality or the part of it on the board of the school district in which the municipality or the part of it is included shall be held at the same time and conducted in the same manner as the annual election of members of the council in the municipality, and by the returning officer appointed for that annual election."
