

COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING FROM THE
 the extensive investigation of the disappearance of a Burnaby girl terminated with the laying of a murder charge against a Coquitlam man. This charge was in conjunction with other identical charges involving discoveries of bodies of youths, in the surrounding districts, who had met death by violence.

The reported Traffic fatalities during the month involved a 19-year-old Vancouver female who died following a three-vehicle collision when the vehicle in which she had been riding went out of control and went into oncoming lanes of traffic and charges have been laid; and, an 83-year-old Vancouver female was thrown from a passenger vehicle after being struck by a heavy dumptruck. Charges are pending. Also, a 20-year-old male passenger from Vancouver was killed in a single vehicle accident when control of the vehicle was lost and it collided with a telephone pole. Charges were laid. A one-month-old infant was killed after a headon collision, when a second vehicle crossed the centre line. Charges are pending.

Investigation into a rash of Break & Entries resulted in the apprehension of two 15/16-year-old youths found responsible for twenty-seven offences of entering residences and schools throughout Burnaby over the past months. Charges are laid.
